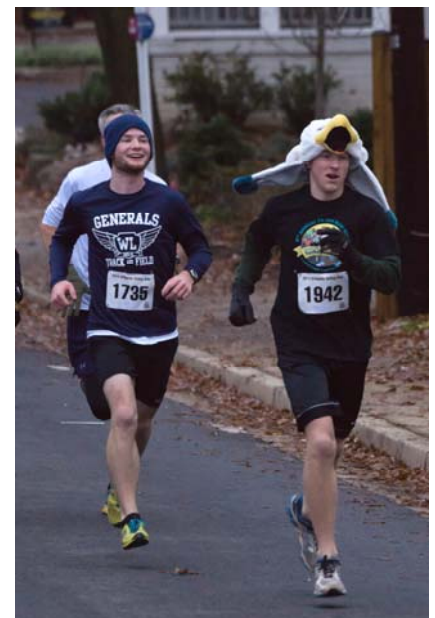
The 11th Annual Arlington Turkey Trot

The first Arlington Turkey Trot took place in 2006, with 300 participants. Together we raised \$4,200 for two local beneficiaries. The number of participants in the race has steadily grown every year as well as the race's impact on the community. In 2015, with over 5,000 registrants, we raised more than \$100,000 for our five local beneficiaries.

Over the past 10 years, the race registrants and business sponsors have raised over \$360,000 to help Arlington residents who need a "hand up."

The race provides an opportunity for people of all ages to enjoy a fun, healthy Thanksgiving activity together, and to raise support for five local beneficiaries: Arlington Food Assistance Center (AFAC), A-SPAN, Arlington Thrive, Bridges to Independence (formerly AACH), and Doorways for Women & Families (Doorways).

In addition, the race itself has become a beloved part of the normal Thanksgiving tradition for many residents of Arlington.
